
Joint PCCs 18th January

Evensong with Portsmouth Cathedral Choir to begin Greatham Church's 150th Anniversary Year 6.30pm 9th February 2025

Preacher: Revd Canon Karen Schmidt

St John's Greatham begin their 150th Anniversary Year with a service of Choral Evensong sung by Portsmouth Cathedral Choir at 1830 on 9th February. The preacher will be the Revd Canon Karen Schmidt. This service looks back and celebrates the life of the Church in Greatham and forward to all that lies ahead

Canon Karen has shared in Benefice services before. She was a colleague of Peter Sutton when he was vicar of Lee-on-the-Solent. Subsequently she was Vicar of St John the Baptist, Purbrook when they celebrated their 150th Anniversary and of St Andrew's Chale, on the Isle of Wight, with whom she celebrated their 900th Anniversary! Karen was Chaplain to Bishop Kenneth Stevenson and Acting Archdeacon of the Isle of Wight before retiring to Swindon. She now assists at St John Baptist, Cirencester.

As we look forward and prepare to enter a period of clergy vacancy it is an opportunity to pray for the future, to look forward to welcoming some familiar and new people who will be leading worship in the coming months and to pray for those, especially our Church Wardens and members of our PCCs, who share in the responsibility of appointing a new priest. This service is the first in a number of special events being planned for the Church's Anniversary year. Bishop Jonathan will be here for Greatham's Patronal Festival in June

With our Cathedral Choir, the service of Evensong is a beautiful and important part of our Christian heritage but also, as a service rooted in the Word of God, an opportunity to celebrate, to think and to pray.
