Morning Prayer from Common Worship is the contemporary version of the morning daily office. It follows a pattern of introduction, psalm(s), readings, canticles including the Benedictus and prayers appropriate to the day. Currently up to 5 or 6 people might come – it is a great way to start the day and there is room for lots more! Morning Prayer last for 20 – 25 minutes.

A New Vicar – Community Drop Ins on Saturday 14th Dec

Each of our Parochial Church Councils have begun the work required to appoint a new vicar. The PCCs are having a number of joint meetings to prepare a Parish Profile which they hope to complete by the end of January. The Parish Profile is a document which describes the parishes, the churches, their strengths and weaknesses, and most importantly, their aspirations for the future. It is in effect a job description as well as a person specification for potential applicants for the post.

Do you have views? Would you like to contribute to the content of our Parish Profile? Those who are regulars in our churches will have opportunity to express what they think but even if you don't attend church, you can still have a say. The church belongs to everyone – so what would you like your parish church to be like in the future? What kind of vicar do you think is needed?
